

ACADEMIC ADVISING COUNCIL

Functions

The Academic Advising Council is responsible for, but not limited to:

- Acting as an advisory group on issues, policies, and procedures related to advising across the campus,
- Developing resources and workshops to promote better advising across campus; and
- Coordinating and implementing the Outstanding Faculty Advisor Award.

Membership

The Academic Advising Council is appointed by the President and reports to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. The committee will be co-chaired. The Council shall elect co-chairs at the last meeting of the Spring Quarter. Council membership is as follows:

- A representative from the College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences, nominated by the Dean of the College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences
- A representative from the College of Architecture and Environmental Design, nominated by the Dean of the College of Architecture and Environmental Design
- A representative from the Orfalea College of Business, nominated by the Dean of the Orfalea College of Business
- A representative from the College of Engineering, nominated by the Dean of the College of Engineering
- A representative from the College of Liberal Arts, nominated by the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts
- A representative from the College of Science and Mathematics, nominated by the Dean of the College of Science and Mathematics
- A representative from Student Academic Services, nominated by the Vice President for Student Affairs
- A representative from Career Services, nominated by the Vice President for Student Affairs
- A representative from Office of the Registrar, nominated by the Assistant Vice Provost for Systems and Resource Management
- A representative from Academic Programs, nominated by the Vice Provost for Academic Programs & Undergraduate Education
- Two faculty representatives from different colleges, nominated by the Academic Senate Executive Committee
- Two student representatives, nominated by the President of the ASI, Inc.
- An Athletics advising representative, nominated by the Director of Athletics

The representatives from the colleges shall be drawn from each college's advising center, if one exists. The term of office shall be two years, except for the ASI student representative, who shall serve a one-year term. There is no limit to the number of terms a member may serve.

Meetings

Meetings will be called by the co-chairs at appropriate intervals, but no less than once a quarter.
