

Disability Access and Compliance Committee

Functions

The mission of the committee is to discuss, monitor, and evaluate campus-specific issues relating to compliance" with California State University Executive Order 926 (<http://www.calstate.edu/EO/EO-926.html>) and can be expected to produce Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance-related reports to the Chancellor's Office as requested.

ADA Compliance Officer for faculty and staff related issues (Academic Affairs representative)
Director of the Disability Resources Center (Student Affairs representative)
Administration and Finance representative, nominated by the Vice President for Administration and Finance
Contract and Procurement Services representative, nominated by the Director of Contract and Procurement Services
Human Resources representative, nominated by the Director of Human Resources
Information Technology representative, nominated by the Vice Provost and Chief Information Officer, Information Technology Services
Parking and Commuter Services representative, nominated by the Chief of Police
Associated Students, Inc. student representative, nominated by the ASI President
Academic Senate faculty representative, nominated by the Executive Committee of the Academic Senate
Cal Poly Corporation representative, nominated by the Executive Director of the Cal Poly Corporation
Non-MPP representative, nomination coordinated by the Director for Human Resources

The term of office shall be two years. The committee chair will be elected by the membership during the initial fall meeting, which will be convened by the ADA Compliance Officer for faculty and staff related issues. The chair shall serve a one-year term.

Meetings

Meetings shall be convened by the committee chair. The committee will meet at least once a year. Additional meetings may be scheduled if necessary.
