

Functions

The Student Orientation Advising and Registration Committee is responsible for, but not limited to:

- Coordinating and implementing the Student Orientation Advising and Registration
- Managing the budget for the Student Orientation Advising and Registration
- Acting as an advisory group on issues related to advising across campus

Membership

The Student Orientation Advising and Registration Committee is appointed by the President and reports to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. Members of the committee will be appointed annually. The committee will be co-chaired. The coordinator of Orientation Programs will serve as one of the co-chairs. The Committee shall elect the other co-chair at the first meeting of the Fall Quarter, which will be called by the coordinator of Orientation Programs. Committee membership is as follows:

- A representative from the College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences, nominated by the College Dean
- A representative from the College of Architecture and Environmental Design, nominated by the College Dean
- A representative from the Orfalea College of Business, nominated by the College Dean
- A representative from the College of Engineering, nominated by the College Dean
- A representative from the College of Liberal Arts, nominated by the College Dean
- A representative from the College of Science and Mathematics, nominated by the College Dean
- A representative from Student Academic Services, nominated by the Director of Student Academic Services
- A representative from Enrollment Support Services, nominated by the Assistant Vice Provost for Systems and Resource Management
- A representative from Admissions, nominated by the Assistant Vice President for Admission, Recruitment, and Financial Aid
- The coordinator of Orientation Programs from Student Life and Leadership
- A student representative, nominated by the President of the ASI, Inc.

The representatives from the academic colleges shall be drawn from each college's advising center, if one exists. The term of office shall be two years, except for the ASI student representative, whose term will be for one year. There is no limit on the number of terms a member may serve.

Meetings

Meetings will be called by the co-chairs at appropriate intervals, but no less than once a quarter.
